### **POST-SELECTION REQUIREMENTS**

Following selection of the CMAA Scholarship, the receiving student will be expected to maintain an active alliance with CMAA by: submitting bi-monthly (every two months) statements on their educational progress and activities for the CMAA newsletter or online forum, as well as active involvement with the CMAA student Chapter where available.
